

Guidelines of Camera-Ready Paper Preparation for CIERES-GCOE11

ABSTRACT The abstract appears in fully-justified text with 10-point, single-spaced type, and **about 100 words** in length, at the top of the left-hand column as it is here, below the author information. Use the word “ABSTRACT” as the title, in 10-point Times, boldface type and capitalized.

1. INTRODUCTION

This paper includes style, format, number of pages and language for the camera-ready paper for CIERES-GCOE11. Please follow this guideline for all authors of oral and poster sessions.

2. FORMAT

2.1. Page size

Please use A4 size white paper (210×297 mm). The printing area is 170mm×247mm. Nothing outside this area will be printed. The left-side, right-side, top, and bottom margins are 20mm, 20mm, 25mm and 25mm, respectively.

2.2. Page style

The camera-ready paper must be **less than 4 pages** and all manuscripts must be written in English. At the center top of the first page, the title of paper, author name(s), affiliation(s), address(es), corresponding author’s E-mail address, phone number, fax number, and the abstract of paper should be described. Place a blank line below the title, author name(s) and affiliation(s).

The abstract and main text should be two columns. Use single spacing in the body of the text. The section should be numbered starting with “1. INTRODUCTION” after the abstract. Place a blank line between the sections. Acknowledgment and References should not be numbered. Page number should not be added for easily preparing the proceedings book.

2.3. Fonts

Recommended font is Times or Times New Roman. Font size of paper title, author name(s), affiliation(s), abstract, normal text, headings, and text in figure caption are 12 pt bold, 11 pt, 10 pt italic, 10 pt, 10 pt, 10 pt bold, and 10 pt, respectively. The section headings appear in capital letters (e.g., 1. INTRODUCTION) and the sub-section headings should be capital and lower letters (e.g., 2.1 Page size). Acknowledgment and references may be typed with 10 pt.

3. NUMBERING

Figure captions should be below the figures. Table captions should be above the tables. Arabic numerals should be used for figures like Fig. 1, and Arabic numerals for tables like Table 1. Place a blank line between the text and the figures or tables. We strongly recommend using black and white images in your paper because the camera-ready paper will be printed in black and white.

The references appear in listed and numbered with brackets at the end of paper as follows. In the case of referring to the references in the text, the reference number should be described like [1].

The equations are numbered with parentheses as follows

$$C = AB. \quad (1)$$
