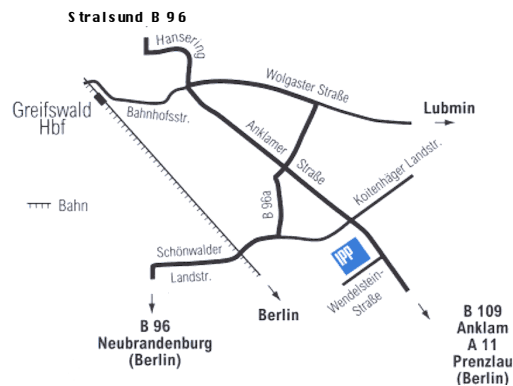


Travelling

by air:

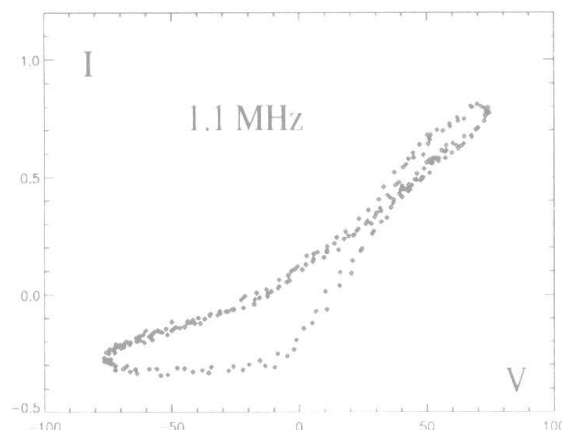
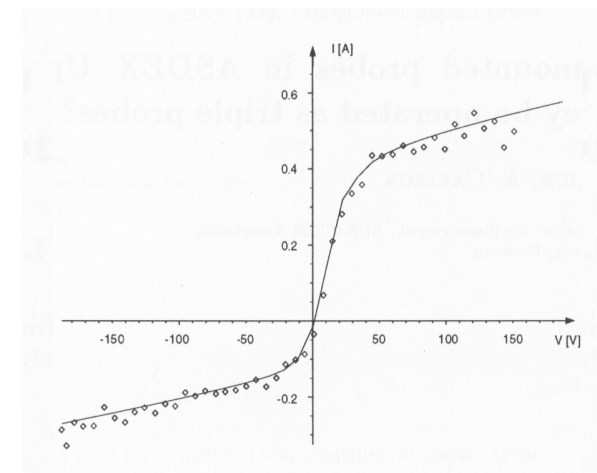

5th International Workshop on Electrical Probes in Magnetized Plasmas, Greifswald

Continuing the series of IPP Berlin probe workshops, we are pleased to announce the 5th International Workshop on Electrical Probes in Magnetized Plasmas, to be held in Greifswald, Germany, on 21-23 July 2003, as a satellite meeting to the XXVIth ICPG conference.

The workshop is being organized by the Max Planck Institute of Plasma Physics, Greifswald Branch. The workshop venue will be the institute building.

Topics

As for the previous workshop, the whole spectrum of problems may be addressed, including:

- mechanisms of electron current saturation
- accuracy of electron temperature measurements
- techniques for measuring the ion temperature
- multiple probe systems, probe arrays
- robust probe tip constructions for high power loads
- fluctuation measurements using probes
- detection and consequences of non-thermal distributions
- sheath and pre-sheath physics
- probes in recombining and drifting plasmas
- advanced and innovative probe concepts.
